Howard Bounds

Howard Bounds, a long time member of the Austin square dance community, passed away on Thursday, April 8, 2010.

Howard was born in Lampasas, Texas and moved to Austin as a child. He served his country in the U.S. Army in Korea. Upon returning home, he married his sweetheart, Bonnie. They were married for over 55 years. Howard & Bonnie had three children and two grandsons.

He was employed with the U.S. postal service and a family business, Johnnie's TV Rental. After he retired he enjoyed working for several years at Hertz Rental at the airport.

Howard & Bonnie were long time members of Central Christian Church. Howard served as a deacon, a greeter, a counter, and a deliverer of donuts.

They were instrumental in the organization of the Flutter Wheels Square Dance Club based at Central Christian. They held numerous offices with the club. After the Flutter Wheels disbanded they joined the Merry Mixers and were honorary members at the time of Howard's passing. After learning to square dance they soon began to serve the ASRDA and continued to do so for over 30 years. They held various appointed and elected offices and were president in 1999 - 2000. They were recognized for their service in 1980 they were named as the first recipient of the Square Dancer of the Year Award.

Their service did not stop at the association level. They worked on many state festival committees and the TSFSRD Social Secretary in 1986 - 1987. Additionally they worked on the 45th and 55th National Square Dance Conventions held in San Antonio.

They loved to square dance and traveled many miles attending TSFSRD meetings and festivals as well as numerous National Square Dance Conventions.

The Austin Square and Round Dance community will greatly miss Howard Lavelle Bounds as he and Bonnie contributed so much to our beloved activity over many years.

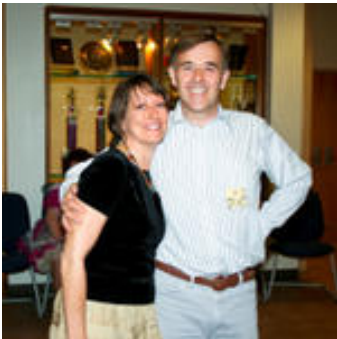
