Thank you to all the officers, delegates, and guests who attended the Austin SRDA business meeting on February 6. It was a good meeting. The teen scholarship dance that evening was fun. The dance donations received were over \$500 and will benefit the Texas Teen Scholarship Program. If you didn't make it to the dance, a donation can still be made. Mail your check to ASRDA, c/o Bill & Myrna Thiessen, 194 E. Guy Street, La Grange, TX 78945.

Another way to help support the Teen Scholarship Program is to get involved with your club in creating a basket to be auctioned off at the annual Mid-Tex Festival. The baskets can be whatever the club wants it to be. Last year there was a basket that went for \$300. The bidding is done by silent auction, so you will want to attend Mid-Tex to bid on the different baskets. Proceeds from the basket auction will be given to the Teen Scholarship Program. It is a great cause to help Texas teens with extra funds to help them through college or trade school. In June 2009 there were eleven \$1,300 teen scholarships awarded.

If you know of any teen dancers that have been dancing for two years and are seniors, remind them to get their applications in to TTSSRDHSG, Inc. as soon as possible. The March 31, 2010 deadline is fast approaching. Last year three applications had to be rejected because they were late.

Our next delegate meeting will be on March 27, 2010 in Luling at the Civic Center. Following the meeting we will support Come N' Take It Squares' 28th anniversary dance. Bill Wright will be calling and the Beckers will be cueing.

The nominating committee met after the business meeting on February 6. The committee had an easy job of coming up with a slate of officers, since the current executive officers agreed to hold their position again. Therefore on March 27, 2010 the following will be nominated: Ed and Martha Koslosky-President; Mary Alice Troxel-Vice President; Bill and Myrna Thiessen-Treasurer; and Theresa Keane-Secretary. 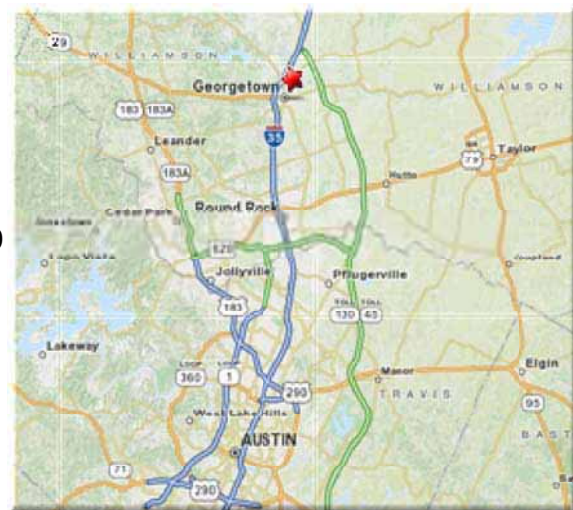
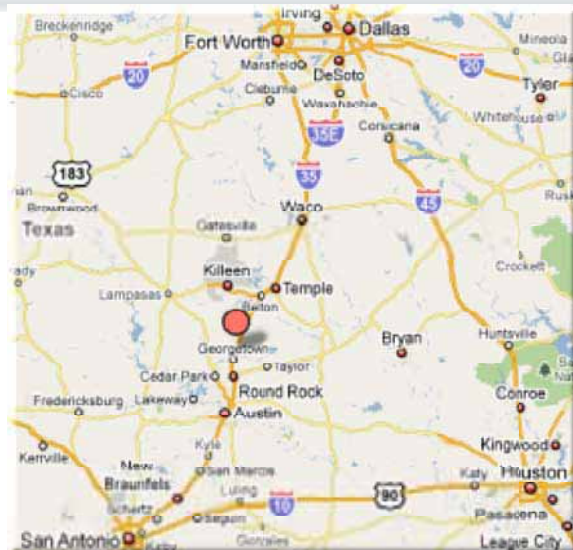
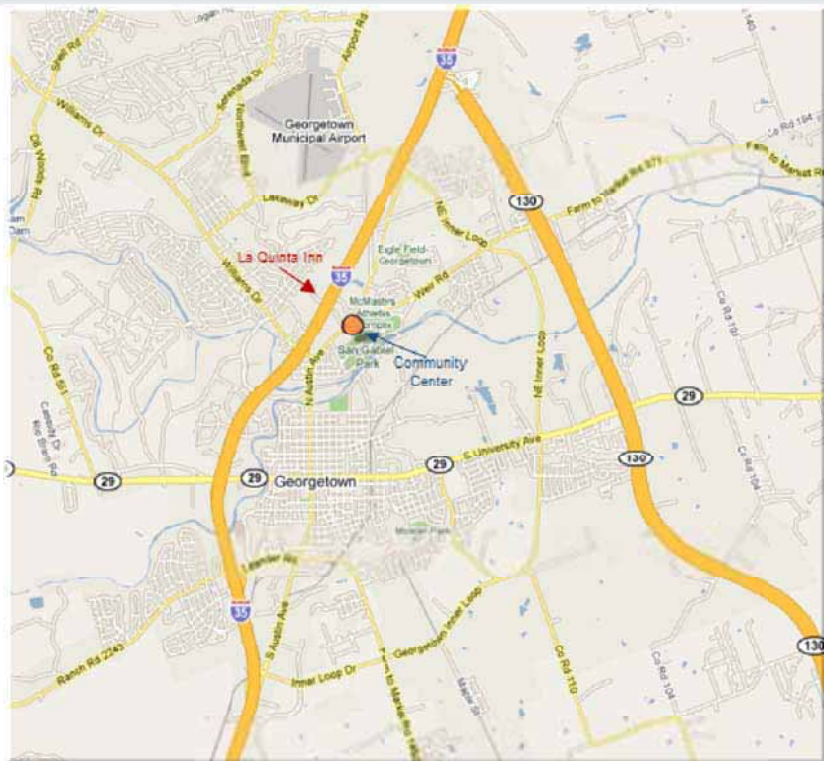
