Others have been visiting dances in Marble Falls and Salado, as well as visiting some of the other clubs in the Austin area.

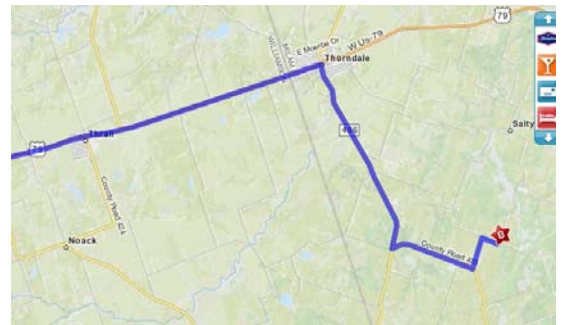
We are sad to report that we have had some of our long time members resign from square dancing due to health reasons, and we have current members suffering from illnesses as well. Our continued prayers are with all of them.

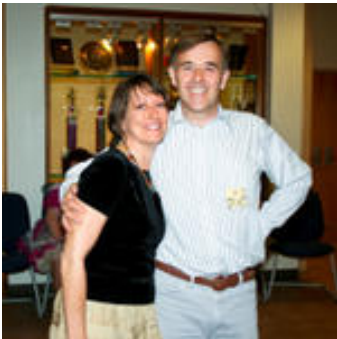
