President's Message: January 2020

Happy New Year Everyone! I hope you all had wonderful holidays and are now ready to start square dancing again. Square dances were scarce from the week of Christmas through the New Year so I'm sure you are ready.

ASRDA has 8 clubs starting mainstream lessons this January! Hopefully your publicity efforts were effective and you all have a bunch of students. I'll be interested to hear how you advertised and how successful you were. Consider sharing that information in your monthly "blurb" for the ASRDA newsletter. We can learn a lot from other clubs – what they did that was successful, what didn't work, and what they would do differently next time.

We also had 3 classes graduate in December. Waterloo graduated a Mainstream class on December 17th, Canyon Lake graduated a Plus class on December 16th, and Hill Country Squares graduated Advanced level dancers on December 29th. Wheel-N-Deals will be graduating its Mainstream class on January 16th, 2020. Great job caller/teachers and clubs! Now let's get those Mainstream graduates to join a club and continue dancing.

In case you don't know, the Alamo Area SRDA is hosting TSFSD dances on January 17th and 18th, 2020 at Colonial Hills United Methodist Church, 5247 Vance Jackson Rd., San Antonio, TX 78230. This is the Federation's Nominating meeting. If you are interested in serving in an elected or appointed position at the State level, let me or Barbara Read know and we will nominate you. You don't have to run for office to come to the dances. Friday Brad Caldwell will be the caller and John Becker will be cueing. Saturday evening the "Mason-Dixon Trio" will be calling (John Carlton, John Kephart, and Ralph Trout) and John Becker will be cueing. Donations for the dances are \$8.00 on Friday and \$10.00 on Saturday. A flyer for the dance is included in this January newsletter.

Speaking of Nominating Committees, the ASRDA will be having its first quarterly meeting of 2020 on Saturday, January 25th at Hyde Park Christian Church in Austin at 2 pm. This is the meeting where we form the ASRDA's Nominating Committee. Forming the committee is only a small part of the general delegate meeting. Delegates will receive an agenda for the meeting NLT January 11th, 2020. If you are interested in being an elected or appointed ASRDA officer to serve from July 2020 – June 2021, let me or your club representative know. There will be meetings of the Conclave Committee and the Mid-Tex Committee following the delegate meeting.

My New Year's resolution is to get around to all the clubs on a regular basis. Barbara Read and I want to go over the New Dancer Orientation booklet with you to see if you have any questions. We also want to make sure you understand the Reimbursement Guidelines. I'd also like to dance with your clubs and listen to how you recruited students. My priorities will be graduations and special events at first but then I hope to attend regular dances. If there is a particular dance you would like the ASRDA board members to attend, please let us know.

I want to remind everyone of the Mid-Tex Festival on May 8th and 9th in Georgetown. Charlie Robertson is calling and Pat and Joe Hilton will be the cuers. This year's Mid-Tex has a lot more round dance time than past festivals have had without decreasing the amount of square dance time. We are asking for donations for the brown bag auction and a basket donation from the clubs. This year there will be a monetary prize give to the club whose basket brings in the most money. Please see the Mid-Tex flyer included in this newsletter.

Finally, I want to remind everyone to keep visiting other clubs. The \$200 visitation award can still be yours. The cut-off date for visitation is April 17th so clubs can turn in their visitation certificates on April 18th at the ASRDA meeting. The prize will be awarded at Mid-Tex.

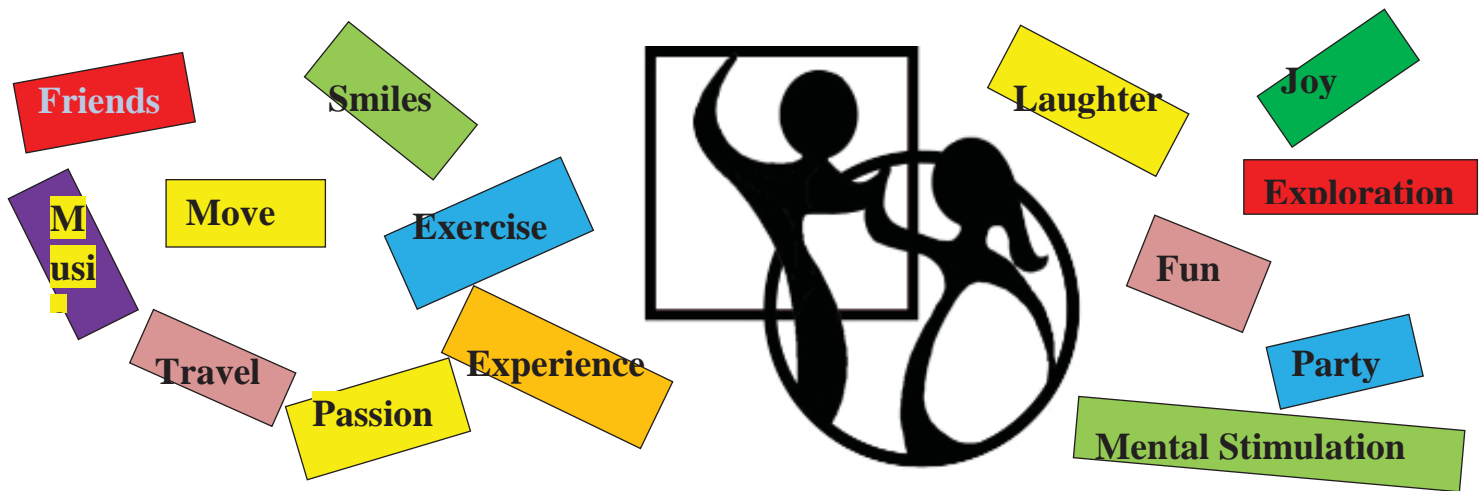

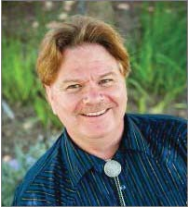
