Message From the President March 2023 Bridge to Community

Hello everyone!

Thank you all for the wonderful ASRDA meeting we had in January. We have a lot of things going on in our organization. I'm very excited about the work that Mike Goggin and Brooke Peters are doing to make our website more appealing as well open infinite possibilities to spread the word about our organization and member clubs. I'm anticipating great collaboration as we each add our own ideas to this venture.

Is the National Square Dance Convention really coming to Texas? Ramona and I have agreed to be the assistant general chairman of the convention which we will bidding on March 22, 2023. At this point we are looking at Waco for 2026 nationals. Some concerns about this choice are the lack of airport and inadequate public transportation. Members of the National Executive Committee (NEC) do not believe the lack of an airport will be much of a hinderance. UPDATE ON NEW WEBSITE

The "Website Team" (Mike Goggin, Vickie Merchant, and Brooke Peters) is still working on the new website. This "Team" has a good mix of talents. Mike Goggin has been in the IT world forever and has served as our webmaster for many years. He patiently answers multiple "how to" questions from Vickie and Brooke. Vickie also has web design experience and is particularly good with graphics and thinking out of the box so the website will hopefully have a fresh new feel and be fun and easy to navigate. One of the new and exciting functions will be in the "Events" section. This is where all the special dances will be listed in chronological order. There will be a link to see the flyer and a link to see a map. THEN you can click another link and the map will automatically transfer itself to Google Maps on your phone so you will have instant directions AND clicking on another link will put the dance directly on your Google calendar!

We are not yet sure when the website will go live. Hopefully it will be prior to our next ASRDA meeting in April 2023. The website will be easy to navigate for anyone who is used to looking up information on websites. The Team will be offering several "Introductory Tours" of the new site via Zoom. Participants will be shown what information is on the website and where to find it, new and exciting functions, and give participants a chance to ask questions. Hopefully by the April 2023 RCS Newsletter the new website's "go live" date will be announced.

Thank you to all the club presidents who have been so responsive in sending information the team has requested. For those clubs who have not yet sent in their logos or corrected any errors in your club's location or time it dances, please do so as soon as you can. There is much information to get updated and the team wants to get the correct information on the site the first time. Each club has been asked to send in their logo but it is particularly important for clubs who do not currently have an active website. The Team will be creating a webpage within the ASRDA website for those clubs needing a website.






